The Reds are putting themselves and others at risk for foodborne illness. Picking while ill, picking into dirty containers, and bringing pets, food, and drinks into the fields could all cause crosscontamination in the fields and potentially pass harmful bacteria and viruses to others. Mrs. Red and the dog should stay out of the field or go home. The Reds should eat all food and drinks before going into the field, throw them away and wash their hands before going into the field. They should only use clean & sanitized picking containers.
